HAZY MEADOW SPORT HORSE CENTER is a complete boarding and training facility located in the beautiful and unspoiled El Monte River Valley in Lakeside, California. We enjoy probably the best weather anywhere, with moderate temperatures, lots of sunshine and a wonderful ocean breeze.

The facility was custom designed and built by owner, Linda Hayes, and her family in 1986. The facility is designed for dedicated horse competitors, as well as pleasure riders. **HAZY MEADOW SPORT HORSE CENTER** has wonderful trail access from the property, and is located a short 40 minutes from the fabulous trails of California's Cuyamaca State Park.

HAZY MEADOW SPORT HORSE CENTER is a fully lighted facility open from 5:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., 365 days a year. Owners and staff live on the premises.

Amenities Include:

Jumping Arena

150 x 225, fully lighted, jumping arena with sand footing, harrowed 6 days a week

Dressage Court

Full regulation size with sand footing, harrowed 6 days a week

Exercise Track

1/4 mile scenic retreat from arena work that is harrowed regularly

Lunging Pen

55 ft, sand footing with 12 foot gated enclosure, sprinklered and lighted

Hot Walker

Fenced, reversible with variable speed

Grass Turn Out Pastures.

Several one and two acre grass pastures which are seeded and irrigated regularly



Horse facilities include:

Deluxe Barn

\$485.00 / Month*

12 x 12 stalls, with 1 2x24 runs, rubber mats, shavings, automatic fly system, automatic waterers, hot water shower stalls, double Dutch doors, and individual closets in the barn group tack room, and winter blanket service.

"Condos"

\$410.00 / Month*

12 x 16, three sided shelters that open into a 16 x 20 run. Each "condo" has its own tack room. Winter blanket services are included.

Pipe Corrals 24x24

\$325.00 / Month*

Six foot six rail, welded so that horses can not get their heads through to rub out manes with substantial shelters. Each corral has a tack cubicle.

Pipe Corrals 1 6x36

\$310.00 / Month*

Six foot six rail, welded so that horses can not get their heads through to rub out manes with substantial shelters. These corrals have use of a large shared tack room.

Feed

Horses receive two feedings daily, of individual choice of excellent quality, barn -stored grass or alfalfa hay. Daily supplements (provided and pre-prepared by horse's owner) will be fed at no additional charge.

Lunch option is available at nominal cost.
